Information regarding the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Championships will be given to qualified skaters at their respective sectional championships and will be available for download for all qualified skaters at [www.usfsonline.org](http://www.usfsonline.org)

The 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Qualifying Competition Season consists of a total of 14 events including, 12 qualifying events (9 Regional Championships, 3 Sectional Championships), the 2009 U.S. Junior Championships (Juvenile & Intermediate) and the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Championships (Novice, Junior & Senior). All 14 events are sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and conducted according to the most current U.S. Figure Skating rulebook, 2009 edition, with changes and clarifications as posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website and this announcement. Compliance with these rules as updated or amended is the responsibility of the participants. U.S. Figure Skating reserves the right to incorporate revisions to the International Judging System (IJS) made by the ISU for Junior and Senior events and by U.S. Figure Skating to Novice events and below.

The Qualifying and National Championship Competitions are only open to competitors who are current members of U.S. Figure Skating and who meet the eligibility requirements according to U.S. Figure Skating Rule 3035, all age and test requirements pertaining to the event you are entering, and the citizen and residency requirements as stated in Rule 3065.

Non-U.S. Citizens who have already received a letter of permission from the Chair of the Competitions Committee and were accepted to compete in the U.S. Figure Skating qualifying system are eligible to register. All other non-US citizens seeking eligibility must meet the requirements set forth in Rule 3065.

**Important Notice for all Coaches (New)**

**NEW PROCESS THIS YEAR!** All coaches will have to comply with the coaches' registration policy in order to be allowed to instruct/coach at all qualifying competitions. Coaches will need to check-in at the registration desk and show proof of registration plus membership in both U.S. Figure Skating and PSA in order to receive a credential. Each LOC will ask to see each coach's registration and membership cards at check-in. If they have not registered, they will not be allowed a credential. No exceptions.

***IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL PAIRS AND DANCE TEAMS***

All pairs and dance teams will begin their qualifying at their respective sectional championships (unless they have been notified of a bye advancing them directly to the U.S. Championships). These events will no longer be offered at the regional championships.

U.S. Figure Skating, the host club(s), the organizing committee, and the ice arena being utilized for these events accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in these championships (see Rule 3222).



## REGISTRATION

### BYES

No medical byes will be considered. Competitors awarded a bye to their sectional championships or the U.S. Championships will receive official notification in writing from U.S. Figure Skating. However, all competitors, including those who receive a bye, wishing to compete in the 2009 Qualifying Competition Season must enter by the stated deadline.

### ENTRY FEES

Those singles skaters advancing, regardless of method, from their regional championships to the sectional championships will incur an additional \$150.00 (one hundred fifty dollars) entry fee plus \$10.00 (ten dollars) administrative fee. This total will automatically be charged to the credit card that paid the initial fee.

All Novice, Junior and Senior pairs and dance teams were charged the \$150 entry fee plus administrative fee during the initial registration process. No additional entry fee for these teams will be charged. Juvenile and Intermediate pairs and dance teams were charged an entry fee of \$130 plus administrative fee and no further fees will be collected from these teams. Singles skaters who receive a bye from their regional championships directly to the sectional championships will only be charged the sectional entry fee of \$150.00.

**Your registration fee is not considered valid until all appropriate entry and administrative fees have been paid and all required forms have been completed online to U.S. Figure Skating.**

### PAYMENT

Online payment via credit card is the ONLY accepted form of payment. For those competitors advancing to sectionals from their regional championships, the credit cards used for the initial entry process will be automatically charged the additional sectional entry fee.

### CONDUCT OF EVENTS

For the 2009 season, all events and levels at all championship competitions (regionals, sectionals, U.S. Junior Championships, U.S. Championships) will be conducted in accordance with the International System of Judging (IJS).

### AGE and TEST QUALIFICATIONS

All age and test requirements can be found in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook starting with USFS Rule 3640 (Senior singles) and on the U.S. Figure Skating website at [http://www.usfigureskating.org/New\\_Judging.asp?id=311](http://www.usfigureskating.org/New_Judging.asp?id=311)

### TECHNICAL ELEMENTS

The well-balanced program charts for all levels and disciplines are posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website at [http://www.usfigureskating.org/New\\_Judging.asp?id=311](http://www.usfigureskating.org/New_Judging.asp?id=311). As referenced earlier in this announcement, U.S. Figure Skating will incorporate all changes made by the ISU in regards to well-balanced programs. Please refer to this website often for continuous updates.

### Withdrawals

**Once entered, all withdrawals are considered final. A skater may not reenter even if the withdraw occurs prior to the entry deadline on Sept. 1, 2008.**

### Planned Program Content Sheet

All competitors entering into the 2009 Qualifying Competition Season are required as part of their online registration to submit a planned program content sheet (PPCS) detailing the elements in their program(s). You may update your PPCS at [www.usfsaonline.org](http://www.usfsaonline.org) up to one week prior to the start of your competition.



### COMPETITION MUSIC INFORMATION

U.S. Figure Skating will require all competitors to fully complete a competition music information form as part of the online registration process.

The following information is required for each piece of music used for the short program/original dance and free skate/free dance: Composer, Orchestra, Duration of Music, Record Label/Number (Optional but highly recommended if obtainable).

For all qualifying events during the 2009 season, CDs are the only acceptable forms of media. **Cassettes will NOT be accepted.** CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. **Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. In the case of short and long programs, two (2) separate disks must be used.** Any disc with more than one (1) track will **NOT** be accepted! Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds. Each CD must be in a standard hard sided "jewel case" or CD sleeve, also labeled with the skater's name and event. Jewel cases and CDs that are not properly identified will **NOT** be accepted. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration and will be available for pick up at the registration desk at the conclusion of the event. At the regional championships, competitors will not receive their credentials at registration until they turn in their music. The originals used at sectionals will be forwarded on to the U.S. Junior Championships/U.S. Championships for those advancing. It is also imperative that all skaters bring original copies of their music to the U.S. Junior Championships/U.S. Championships if so advancing. Skaters advancing to the U.S. Championships will need to provide the name and composer of each piece of music. CDs will not be mailed back to competitors.

All competitors must have at least one (1) additional copy (CD) rinkside at practice sessions and during the actual competition event. The local organizing committee will accept no responsibility for damage or loss of CDs.

U.S. Figure Skating will supply current dance music for compulsory dances.

### ADVANCEMENT TO U.S CHAMPIONSHIPS/U.S. JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

#### QUALIFIERS

Representatives from the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Championships will be present to distribute information packets and to ensure that they receive the required information from those competitors advancing to Cleveland, OH.

The top 8 Juvenile and Intermediate pairs and dance teams will receive their U.S. Junior Championships paperwork from The Skating Club of Boston's representative. All necessary paperwork is to be returned to the U.S. Junior Championships LOC. It must be postmarked by the Tuesday following the end of the event.

#### ALTERNATES

Skaters placing in fifth and sixth place (unless there are fill-ins) at the sectional championship in the Novice, Junior and Senior levels will be designated as first and second alternates. These competitors will be provided an event announcement as they may be selected to compete up to 48 hours before their competition event.

**Alternates do not need to mail in any paperwork or required forms unless contacted by U.S. Figure Skating.**

### OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD

The official bulletin board will contain any announcements or changes and it is the responsibility of the competitors to check it often for official notices. Please refer to the local portion of the announcement for further information.

### ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted at the U.S. Figure Skating Championships, held in Cleveland, Ohio, January 18-25, 2009. Senior level competitors only are eligible to be tested. If selected, testing is mandatory.

## OFFICIAL NOTICES

The official bulletin board will be maintained by the Skating Club of Boston on 1240 Soldiers Field Road. Postings on the Official Bulletin Board will constitute official notice to all competitors and coaches of schedule changes and other competition information. It is the skater's responsibility to check the bulletin board for event or schedule changes. No event will begin prior to the posted start time; however, **skaters should be at the rink and checked in 45 minutes prior to their event.**

## REGISTRATION

The registration desk at The Skating Club of Boston will be open throughout the week. Competitors should check-in at the registration desk upon their arrival to receive their credentials and other important information. Registration will open on Monday, Nov. 10 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Thereafter the registration desk will remain open during all practice and competition hours.



### PRACTICE ICE (See Form B)

Practice ice sessions will begin on Tuesday, November 11, 2008.

Official ice packages are available for purchase. The number of sessions and session time varies based on level and discipline. Please see Form B for the details. Music will be played on official practices only. A 20-minute warm up session per event entered is included in the official ice packages. Warm up sessions will be scheduled for all competitors on the day of the event. All official ice packages include one Official Program Book, one 2009 Easterns Commemorative Pin and the \$10 photo submission fee will be waived.

Unofficial practice ice is available and may be pre-reserved for \$17 per skater, per session. All sessions will be 25-minutes in length. Depending on availability, sessions will be sold for \$25 per competitor on-site.

The enclosed form (Form B) must be completed and submitted with a check to guarantee official, and if requested, unofficial practice ice times. Please make check payable to The Skating Club of Boston and include with your entry packet. A schedule will be posted online as soon as it is available – please check the website at [www.easterns2009.com](http://www.easterns2009.com) often for current information. ### OFFICIAL PROGRAM AND MEDIA INFORMATION

All qualifying skaters, whether advancing through a BYE or advancement from the regional championships, are required to provide two (2) 5x7" head/shoulder photos labeled with the name of the competitor(s), home club, event level, and coach. Digital media files should be in Tiff, EPS or PDF format (300 dpi or greater). Please email the image(s) to Mary Naphtal at [operations@peinvestments.com](mailto:operations@peinvestments.com) or, if sending printed photos, enclose with your forms submission found at the end of this announcement. There is a \$10 fee, which will be waived with the purchase of an official ice package. All submissions must be emailed or postmarked no later than the Tuesday (SA) or Thursday (NE, NA) following your regional championships.

### PHOTOGRAPHY and VIDEO

Competition performance videotaping will be provided by and available for purchase from the official event videographer assigned by U.S. Figure Skating. All U.S. Figure Skating Championship Competitions (including sectionals) will be professionally videotaped and photographed. Videotaping of the competition in any form is not permitted. Photographs are permitted for personal use only. No flash photography is allowed and resale of photos is strictly prohibited.

### AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the first through fourth place finishers and trophies will be awarded to the first place winner. Check the bulletin board for award schedule and location.

### COMPETITORS' PARTY

### Credentials (See Form A)

Security will be in place and entry will be limited to credentialed and ticketed individuals only.

**Chaperone Credentials:** Each skater may name one chaperone to receive credentials free of charge. One additional chaperone credential may be purchased for \$45.00. Chaperones will not have access to skater locker rooms or staging areas.

**Coaches Credentials:** Each singles entry may designate a maximum of two coaches for credentials; each pair and dance team may designate a maximum of three coaches for credentials. One coach credential per competitor will be provided free of charge; all others are \$45.00 each. All coaches must be current U.S. Figure Skating and PSA members in good standing and show proof of coach's registration to be credentialed. Coaching credentials will allow access to all venue areas, including coaches' hospitality.

**Changes:** Changes to chaperone and/or coach designations may be made at the registration desk. Competitors will be limited to one chaperone and one coach designation change. Only a skater who is not a minor, or a parent or legal guardian of a minor skater may designate or change an official chaperone or coach.

**Replacement cost for any lost or missing credential is \$45.00.**
